MOHAMED AL ASSAM

Born in Baghdad (b. 13 Mar. 1948) to a middle class family, with roots in the old city of Najaf. As the son of both ancient cities of Baghdad and Najaf, important factors that played a major role in the thinking and performance of Al Assam as an individual, an architect, and at a later stage, as urban planner.

Mohamed completed his high school with an outstanding score, allowing him to apply and get into the Architecture School of Baghdad University, established by the "Godfather" of Iraqi architects Dr. Mohamed Makkiya (1914 - 2015), which witnessed the arrival of the first generation of Iraqi architects who studied in prominent schools abroad and returned with dominating architectural views of that time.

An introductory lecture by Dr. Makkiya in the "Critique Auditorium" about the leading role of the Architect as The Master of "Techts/Craftsmen", and how the profession of architecture has a major responsibility in the development of a civil society, left a great impact on Al Assam, and filled him with pride and responsibility in being actively involved in a profession that is locally rooted, to design functional buildings with quality craftsmanship and strong aesthetics, and that allow its inhabitants to use these buildings with a great sense of happiness given the intelligent spatial relations and use of "honest" building materials.

Given the above, Mohamed was not a fan of any particular style or architectural theory, but rather learnt architecture from the passion of doing, and designing fit-for-use and performance architecture. Mohamed strongly believed that the architect should be like a "barometer" of the society he lives in, responding to the changing needs of its inhabitants with a strong sense of social responsibility.

Upon completion of the 5 years BSc. program in Architecture, Al Assam was fortunate in securing short employments along Iraqi masterarchitects like Dr. Makkiya, in his beautiful at elier in a Baghdadi traditional house, overlooking the Tigris. Mohamed remembers his contribution to the State Mosque project in Kuwait. Another short employment was with Rifaat Chadirji (b. 1926), and his vanguard team led by Ma'ath Al Alousi (b. 1938), where Al Assam enjoyed the impressive presentation techniques of the office and worked on developing drawings for a Stadium in Bahrain.

In the public sector, Al Assam worked for the Iraqi Ministry of Public Works, during his engagement with Mehdi Al Hasani office (b. 1930...). At that stint, Al Assam was entrusted with his first encompassing project for the design and management of the Headquarters of the Iraqi Navy Force in Basra.

Mohamed's entrepreneurial bug, thrusted Mohamed to establish his own practice in 1974 with Zuhair Al Ansari (b. 1946...), in a search for additional independency and liberty of expression. Key projects from that period, like the collaboration with the office of another Iraqi pioneer Architect Hisham Munir (b. 1930) for the design of Assembly Halls and Kindergartens in the Samawa Governorate (now Muthana - Iraq).

Thearchitect's professional consultancy works in Iraq's 1970s were tied to a gloomy centralized and repressive political system, which had negatively affected all professions and their ability for growth and development. As an outcome of that limiting atmosphere, and in search for security, professional dignity and freedom, Mohamed elected to immigrate from his home country and to explore new opportunities in the emerging new cities of the Gulf Region.

Al Assam moved to the U.A.E in 1976. In the UAE, only the larger cities of Dubai and Abu Dhabi had the shape of real cities at that time. In this sensitive environment, Mohamed's firm Dewan Architects + Engineers emerged and established itself (established in Abu Dhabi 1984) as a leading contributor to the cityscapes of the UAE through its practices in Abu Dhabi, Dubai, and later in Baghdad, Barcelona, Manila, Sahrjah, and Riyadh.

Over the past 35 years, DEWAN has focused on developing its name and brand as a "design-led" architectural firm. Different clients will have varying requirements and visions for their respective developments. With this in mind, Dewan Architects + Engineers has always been especially sensitive to these client directions without compromising the form and function of its designs.


Dewan has maintained its solid reputation as "The Quality Architects" and has maintained an impressive client portfolio of the largest developers and clients in the region. The office continues to grow its portfolio across the region and with forays into Africa, CIS countries, and SE Asia, firmly establishing itself as an international practice.

As a homage to his "Birth Country", Al Assam seized the first opportunity to return to Iraq after the war of 2003 and the fall of the previous regime, and contributed significantly to most of the new developments and reconstruction efforts across Iraq including largescale projects like The 1st prize international award winning, Urban Renewal of the Old City of Kadhimiya in Baghdad, and similar Urban Renewal and Rejuvenation projects for the old city centres of Najaf, Karbala as well as master planning and urban planning work for Basra and Dewaniya.

In addition to Educational developments for Universities of Samarra, Karbala, Kufa and many other public buildings like the Basra Governorate, Najaf City Council, Court buildings, and many other hospitality and sports developments. A significant portfolio of projects, which was at a peak time managed by 4 local offices around the country with a large team of architects, engineers, and administrators.

The participation in these projects was metaphorically like a "Reconstruction" of Al Assam's Architectural Memory, to which he dedicated the best time and resources of both himself and his firm, and collaborated with some of the best international experts in the profession to contribute to this process.

Continuing this legacy, Al Assam being a co-founder, is acting now as a Board Member for Makkiya Association (an NGO registered in Baghdad), and a frequent Jury for the International Tamayouz Awards of Architecture. In addition, Mohamed Al Assam & Dewan Architects + Engineers have launched this year 2018 the 1st round of The Annual Dewan Competition Awards for young architects, which will strive to encourage future developments in Iraq, with international exposure and solutions, addressing social needs and challenges, empowering young generations, and promoting a better built environment.
